

REHABILITATION WORK OF EMBANKMENT OF GULL MOHAMMAD WAH

 The small local farmers along with Farmer organizations, JMC have initiated by their own rehabilitate one of the key structure that embankment of Gull Muhammad Wah which is around 5 km long with average 10 feet where 17 focused villages.

• The initial work of earth filling is being carried out by the JMC members and local farmers by

their own.

- Livestock Vaccination Campaign was Organized in Flood Emergency of Nai Gaj District Dadu.
- More than 2570 Animals were vaccinated through the campaign.


PROVISION OF WATER TREATMENT PANT IN FLOOD AFFECTED AREA

SEED DISTRIBUTION IN FLOOD AFFECTED AREAS

- Seed Distributed among 200 farmers of Union council Pat Gull Mohammad and Sawro
- 12 villages of Union council Pat Gull Mohammad and union Council Sawro Taluka johi district Dadu were targeted.
- The small farmers were selected from the areas where flood water was drained so the farmers can cultivate the seasonal crops.





ACTIVITIES WORK PACKAGE 2

Bhag Narri - SPO

- Finished design of improvements for major bottlenecks (8 structures/canals)
- Tendering is completed and work order issued to vendor for major improvements in lower Bhag Narri
 - Contractor selected, works between Nov March 2023
- Preparing tender for upper Narri (construction Dec 22 Jun 23)
- Support to JMC and Farmer Networks, including proper establishment (on-going)
- Updated map of the system, provided print to government offices.
- Monitoring through IrriWatch
- Irrigation construction of water distributer for Buldei wah (part of own contribution). Visit to site remains.

ACTIVITIES WORK PACKAGE 3

Bhag Narri (SPO)

- Monitoring of trials with improved seeds
 - Very promising results, comparison with local varieties
 - Local seed procurement of next seasons
 - Organic Wheat, Cluster Bean, Sorghum, Millet, etc.
- Procurement of goods for upcoming activities
 - Milk Churners In Procurement Process
 - Sewing Machines (vocational skills centre) –
 Purchased and will be delivered in Mid-Nov 2022
 - Laser land levelling

- Additional Practical Notes + Printing (2 completed)
- Supported in proposal writing for Seeds by JICA & package of 3000 bags approved for Bolan and in distribution process.
- UNDP fund for cash for work is approved for district Kachi (Including Project Area). Will be implemented by Taraqee Foundation. Including additional shallow wells (like COVID-19 project)
